Abstract Submission Guidelines

All submissions must follow the guidelines given below.

- All abstracts must be submitted electronically via the Microsoft Conference Management Toolkit (CMT).
- Indicate the conference track that best aligns with your abstract. Please refer to the official conference website for conference tracks.
- Provide a clear and concise title for your abstract.
- Each submission must include both an **Abstract** and an **Extended Abstract**.
- Do not include author names, affiliations, or other identifying information in the abstract or extended abstract. Submissions containing such information will be desk rejected.
- Upon successful submission to Microsoft CMT, you will receive a submission ID and a confirmation email will be sent to all listed authors.

Abstract

- **An abstract of 250 to 300 words** – this should include your objectives, methods or models used, and results or conclusions, as appropriate.
- **Manuscript formatting** – ensure the document is error-free and formatted in a single column with single-spaced text in Calibri font, size 11. Maintain one-inch margins on all four sides of an A4-sized page.
- **Keywords** – include up to **six** relevant keywords (common and/or scientific terms).

Extended Abstract (3 to 4 pages)

- Layout - Manuscripts should generally follow the structure outlined below, though variations may be permitted based on subject-specific requirements:
 - **Title**
 - **Abstract:** A concise summary of 250 to 300 words outlining the study's objectives, methods, and key findings. This should be the same Abstract mentioned above.
 - **Keywords:** Include up to six relevant keywords (common and/or scientific).
 - **Introduction:** Clearly introduce the research topic, emphasizing its significance and providing a brief review of related literature. State the objectives of the study explicitly.
 - **Methodology:** Describe the methods used with appropriate citations. If new or non-standard methods are proposed, highlight their novelty and limitations. Include ethical clearance information where applicable.
 - **Results and Discussion:** Present findings in a clear and logical manner. Discuss their relevance in the context of the study.
 - **Conclusion:** Summarize the main outcomes aligned with the study's objectives. No references should be included here.
 - **Acknowledgements** (if applicable).
 - **References:** Properly cite all referenced work using APA style, both in-text and in the reference list.
- Ensure all tables and figures are clear, numbered sequentially, and appropriately referenced in the text.
